

Beautiful Harrison Lake is a rugged mountain lake located north of

Sandpoint, ID off of the Pack River. There are several activities to do at this location including boulder scrambles and traversing to ridgelines. It's a spectacular view and is well worth the effort. Additionally, there has always been a good supply of huckleberries on this trip!

The trip starts at CLBC, where we will gear up, go over the trip plan, and discuss backcountry safety and ethics. We depart CLBC and travel up the Upper Pack River Road where we find the trailhead and begin the 3.5 mile hike. During the four-day, three-night trip, campers will enjoy day hikes, survival skills, and fellowship. Each day will include Bible studies in order to focus campers on the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the glory of God.
